Using Graphic Organizers to Identify Main Idea

In addition to the main idea, you will find one or more supporting details are included in the selection. Supporting details are pieces of information that tell about the main idea. They define, explain, prove or analyze the main idea of a text. An excellent way of keeping your thoughts in order is to use a graphic organizer — a diagram or drawing that helps you organize your ideas on paper.
