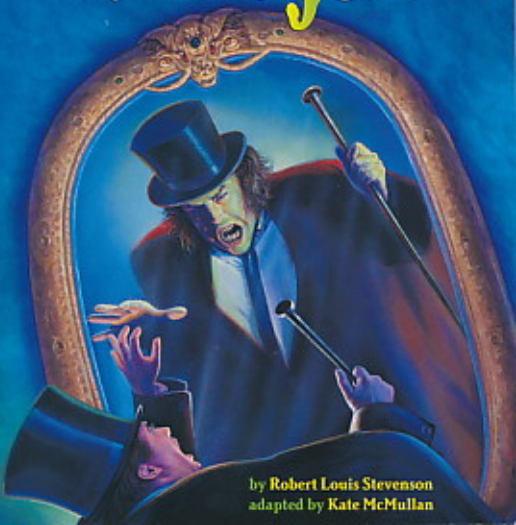

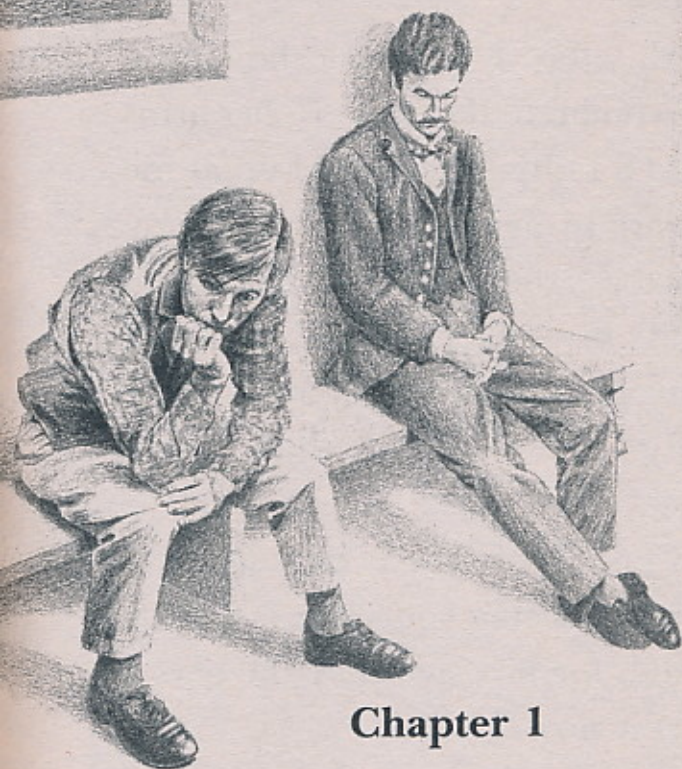
DR. JEKYLL AND MR. HYDE
